## ARTISTSTATEMENT


Niam Jain specializes in gestural abstract art and abstract expressionism. Since discovering his talent at the age of 12, Niam has been internationally recognized for his contributions to the art scene, helping define a new wave of abstract art showing no signs of slowing down. Constantly evolving, Niam has become accomplished and highly regarded in a short window of time, now only 20 years old, painting and exhibiting in group and solo shows.

Niam has autism and limited speech. This does not stop him from creating spectacular & mesmerizing large paintings. Niam relies on intuition and feelings to create layers of paint – each expressing an emotion –by combining colours, textures, and techniques , Jain tells a story that intrigues, compels, and emotionally charges. He paints in colours – vibrant and explosive – complementary and colliding – the bold brushstrokes and complex textures inspire, intrigue and captivate audiences.



With astounding pictorial intuition, Niam composes works that leave audiences changed - considering the complexities involved in turning thoughts into a world of unrestrained abandon, where the viewer is lost in the emotions of the painting. His work reminds us that canvas is a medium of ultimate expression.







#### ABOUT THE ARTIST

Niam Jain is a world renowned, award-winning abstract artist. Niam has become a sought-after emerging artist, and in only 6 years, has impressively sold over 100 paintings internationally including New York, London, Sydney and Los Angeles.

Niam's outstanding large canvas work is displayed in the homes of prominent discerning Private Collectors Corporations and Art Galleries. Niam has had numerous sold-out shows, and has been featured on Canadian media outlets celebrating his artistic gift.

In his Philanthropic efforts, he has donated Over \$10,000 of paintings, including to The Trillium Hospital and UHN. Niam is also giving back to the community, further dispelling myths that Autistics are a burden on society.

Niam's story is featured and studied in a United Kingdom Textbook, "The Game Changer", teaching our new young leaders to be inclusive, and inspiring them to reach their full potential. The story pushes societal boundaries, showing Autistics can be contributing members of society.

Niam dispels myths of non-verbal autistics, by working hard to create a space for himself in the Art World.

## ART DEALER PERSPECTIVE

" Looking at the artwork of Niam Jain, one would be hard-pressed to define its creator. There is great maturity in the use of material, as well as an audacious approach to colour and composition. Hints of Abstract Expressionism, a touch of Jackson Pollock perhaps, maybe Riopelle, the references are many. Yet it would be a great disservice to these artists to group them in this way, and most of all to Niam Jain.

To be placed on the shoulders of such giants in the history of art, and to do it at the tender age of twelve, is a true accomplishment. It becomes even more of a tour de force when one takes into account that Jain has autism. But before any thoughts of pity or doubt arise, the artist himself dispels the myth, attributing his creativity to that very affliction. For rather than hinder his expression, it has fuelled his imagination, releasing, freeing his amazing creative impulse.

If art brut, or outsider art, comes to mind when discussing Jain, it is with reverence not disdain. Coined by the great French artist Jean Dubuffet (1901-1985), it defines "raw art", one created outside the constraints of traditional aesthetics. Dubuffet himself eschewed such limitations, opting for a more authentic approach to making art.

And what could be more authentic than images borne of an unencumbered mind, of an unshackled, if unusual, spirit. Jain paints as if he were channelling some kind of otherworldly energy. The colours explode in his paintings, bursting onto the canvas in bold dabs and brushstrokes, at times with complete abstract abandon, at other grouping into geometric forms and patterns. Like in the works of surrealist Max Ernst, and others who employed automatism in their creative process, Jain seems to be accessing material from the subconscious, without guile or pretence.

With astounding pictorial intuition, this young artist composes works that inspire and intrigue. He invites the viewer into a vibrant world of unrestraint abandon, infused with the pure joy of painting. Jain possesses an innate understanding of the material, adapting to the demands of each medium - be it acrylic on canvas, wood or linen, or prints.

It is, nevertheless, disconcerting, and ultimately futile, to try and reconcile the maturity of the artwork with the tender age, and personal development of its creator. On his colourful website, Jain breaks his creative process into four simple steps that sum it up probably for 99% of all artists. Get paint, prepare, start painting, stop painting. It is what remains after the final phase that sets them all apart. When Jain finishes his painting, the result defies the stance. The mind boggles thinking what the future holds for this supremely talented and unique artist."








